**Emergency Medical Grant (EMG):** Per incident, requests can be 50% of final bill or a maximum of \$1,000. Itemized statement, quote, or bill and prognosis on veterinarian's letterhead, and photo and description attachments to accompany application.

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**Humanitarian Grant:** Please refer to the Trust's Rescue web page for requirements.

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**Other Requests:** Written request and all pertinent information are required.

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**Mass Surrender/Seizure Grant:** This grant helps Rescues and local Shelters/Humane Societies that receive a number of Siberians at one time due to a surrender or seizure situation. The number of dogs required to be considered as a "mass" situation depends both on the number of dogs received and the size of the receiving organization. Documentation, description, & photos to accompany the application process. Contact the Trust's Rescue Coordinator for more information.
