FOWL PLAY EXPECTED

Knowing what a crafty breed the Siberian Husky can be, we fully expect similar behavior from their owners. Therefore, in advance of the **2015 MINI RUBBER DUSKY DERBY**, we felt the need to establish some additional rules.

CUSTOMIZATION

In response to requests for the ability to customize one's sponsored **DUSKY**, we will allow customization under these restrictions:

1. For a nominal fee of \$2.00, sponsored **DUSKIES** may be signed out by their sponsor or agent at any time BEFORE the day of the Derby. **DUSKIES** will be available at the SHCA Trust table.
2. **DUSKY** customization/decoration may include (but not be limited to) changing their color, adding a name, adding ballast (they are a bit top-heavy), etc.
3. **DUSKY** customization/decoration may not remove or change the assigned number.
4. **DUSKY** customization/decoration may not interfere with other **DUSKIES** while in competition. Duskyies are subject to all fines and disciplinary action indicated in rule #9 of the published official Rubber **DUSKY** Derby Rules and Regulations.
5. Customization may NOT include addition of motors (electric, battery, rubber band, outboard, etc.).
6. Customization/decoration may NOT significantly change the original shape of the Dusky. For example, a **DUSKY** may not be placed in a boat.
7. **DUSKIES** must be returned by 9:00 AM on the day of the Derby, at which time they will be inspected for violations. Necessary fines will be levied and disciplinary actions will be taken prior to the start of the first derby heat. **DUSKIES** returned late will be subject to a fine and/or disqualification.
8. All decisions of the Derby Race Committee will be final.
9. The Derby Race Committee takes no responsibility for customization/decoration that is damaged while the **DUSKY** is in charge of the Derby Race Committee.

DERBY RACES

1. During the Derby, sponsors, agents, and friends are admonished to remember the published official Rubber **DUSKY** Derby Rules and Regulations, #9 in particular.
2. However, those wishing to aid their **DUSKY** in his or her progress should remember that the use of motorized (electric, battery, rubber band, etc.) wind making machines is not allowed, and **DUSKIES** associated with such cheating will be disqualified. Leaf blowers, dog blowers, etc., are strictly forbidden.
3. Subtle encouragement of one's own **DUSKY** is allowed within reason; blowing through a small straw may be allowed, while using a bellows will not.
4. Remember that the definition of subtle encouragement is the decision of the Derby Race Committee.

We encourage everyone to remember that this Derby is for fun (and, of course, fabulously cheesy prizes), and our Siberians will benefit both from the sponsorship of the **DUSKIES**, as well as any fines paid.
